## Food Allergies

Due to the increase in childhood allergies, our childcare is proud to offer your children an allergen-free zone.

What does this mean? This means that inside the lobby and inside the walls of the childcare there is absolutely no food, candy, or gum! So please check pockets for those little ones hiding their leftover fruit snacks and candy. Children can have water bottles or sippy filled with water-cups only. Infants (and toddlers that still need it) may enjoy their bottles in the infant room only. In the lobby, food must be sealed in air tight packaging so that no vapors may be expelled.

### **Absolutely no peanuts!**

Please let us know of any allergies upon check-in so that we can help ensure the safety of your child.

Children have allergies of many forms that can be triggered in many ways, and we at Great Lakes Athletic Club do not want to take any chances with these precious young lives. Please support us in keeping our childcare an allergen-free zone.

**If peanut and/or nut type foods were eaten just prior to arriving to the center, please wash hands and face and rinse the mouth before entering.**
